

## How Do We ImPact the Next Generation of Female Coders?

#### Clubhouse

We provide after-school and weekend classes that cover a wide range of STEM topics for all levels of skill and experience.

### Micro:bit for All

We work with districts in our communities to get a micro:bit kit in the hands of every 5th grader in the DMV (District of Columbia, Maryland, Virginia).

#### **Girl Scouts**

We offer certificates for completion of the Coding Basics badge following Clubhouse classes, which are always free for Girl Scouts. Troops and individuals are welcome!

### Ambassadors

We host virtual events featuring successful women in STEM to show girls what kind of jobs they could have.

#### Student-teachers

We provide leadership opportunities to girls who graduate from our programs or other STEM programs and want to work for us as instructors.

#### Summer Camp

We offer camps for girls ages 7+ to learn computer science and engineering fundamentals through a series of unique projects and hands-on challenges.

#### **Curriculum for schools**

We work with teachers and school districts to develop and share lesson plans for in-school STEM learning and after-school programs like Clubhouse.

#### Scholarships:

We offer full scholarships for any students who cannot afford to pay for Clubhouse. We also offer scholarships for our after-school programs in Title 1 (low-income) schools.




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## 2024 ImPact By Program
